 - MPCA Class D Wastewater Operator Certificate;
 - MPCA Type 4 Sludge Certificate; and
 - Minnesota Special Class Boilers Operating Engineers License.
- Advancement to MPCA Class B Wastewater Operator Certificate as permitted by in-service time and training not to exceed a maximum of six (6) years from bid award.

The following are highly desirable qualifications when hiring:

- Graduation from Technical/Community College training program with specialized training in wastewater operations.
- Training and/or experience in the operation, maintenance, repair and service of a wastewater treatment facility and collection system lift stations and related equipment.
- Possession of a CDL license with tanker endorsement.
- Possession of MPCA Wastewater Class C or higher Operator certificate.
