### **BPU Customer Bills have a New Look**

Brainerd Public Utilities new bill has many new features; your service types are now separated and will display your total electric charges, your total water charges, and the combined total.

Service charges now appear on separate lines and are no longer combined as one electric or water line item. We have also included the rates for each service. Our payment receipt, to submit with your payments when paying in person or via mail, is now at the bottom. You will find the same additional information on the back side of the bill, as was provided on our previous bill, for your convivences.

BPU has many options for you to pay your bill. You pick what is suitable for you.

Pay Online: To pay your bill online at BPU.org. If you are a first time user, you will need to know your BPU account number and the amount of your last payment.

Automatic Payments (ACH): Want one less check to write and ensure that your bill is paid on time? Go to www.bpu.org >Billing >automatic Payment (ACH) click on form.

Pay by Phone: You can make a payment 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, through our automated payment system. Please call 218-829-8726 - Option 3.

You will need to know YOUR BPU ACCOUNT NUMBER, it is on your bill.

Pay by Mail: You can mail your payment stub, along with a check or money order, each month to BPU, P O Box 373, Brainerd MN 56401.

PLUS we have paperless billing. Please go to our website www.bpu.org and sign up for e-bills through "Pay Your Bill" or call our business office at 218-829-3200 and we can assist you.
